


# LOCAL GOVERNMENT STREAMLINES PROCESSES, REDUCES COSTS AND ACHIEVES GREEN PRINTING



In keeping with its reputation as one of the top performing boroughs in England's West Midlands Region, as well as its four-star ranking by the national Audit Commission, the Telford & Wrekin Council was searching for ways to streamline administration functions, reduce its office operating costs and integrate sustainable business practices into its everyday activities. The Council quickly recognized that improving control over its printing, copying, scanning and faxing operations would help improve employee efficiencies, cut costs and minimize paper waste.

"Of greatest importance was finding a solution that could potentially be used by everyone in the Council," said the borough's Cabinet Member for Resources. "In our ideal world, employees could walk up to any device, authenticate themselves and immediately print the documents they needed — even if they were not in their usual building."

For its transformation into a greener, more efficient and scalable office environment, Telford & Wrekin Council selected Xerox to manage the deployment of new Xerox WorkCentre™ multifunction devices (MFDs) with Equitrac Office® 4 software and Follow-You Printing® technology providing integrated print management, job tracking and user mobility.

"This project was an important undertaking and we weren't reticent to scrutinize the capabilities and business practices of potential partners," explained the Council's Project Sponsor. "Xerox was a confident choice. "By transitioning our equipment from a single purpose device like a printer or copier into a fleet of multifunction
